RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. In classes for livestock, each exhibit must have been the bona fide property of exhibitor for not less than one month prior the Show.
2. In Sections 8, 9, 10 and 11 (Seeds, Grain, Roots and Vegetables,) all entries must be the bona fide property of, and grown by, exhibitor for the current season.
3. All exhibits must be in their appointed places by 9.30am on the morning of the Show. No exhibits of any description will allowed to be removed from the Show Grounds until 4.00pm on day of Show without the permission of the Committee or Secretary.
4. Outdoor/Indoor Produce: All entrants to uplift exhibits by 5.00pm on Show Day and should such produce not be removed by that time, it shall be deemed to belong to the Association, who shall dispose of it at their discretion.
5. The Committee will not, under any circumstances, hold themselves responsible for loss, damage, or miss-delivery of exhibits of any description, whether exhibited at the Show or during transit to or from same.
6. All prizes not claimed within two weeks after the Show Date shall be forfeited.
7. All protests must be lodged with the Event Administrator in writing not later than two hours after the Judges have given their decisions. The party entering the protest must deposit \$50.00, which will be returned if the protest is upheld. The Committee will meet on the day of the Show to consider all protests, five members to form a quorum. The decision of the Committee for the time being in office shall be absolutely final in all cases.
8. This show supports the RAS "Yellow Card" system, which will be offered for any inappropriate behaviour towards Show Officials, Judges, Fellow Competitors or any other third party connected with the Show. Implementation of the "Yellow Card" will be in accordance of the RAS Rules that accompanied this card, and full wording of the "Yellow Card" system is available to view on the RAS Website.
9. Persons desirous of exhibiting goods for which there are no classes in the Catalogue may, subject to the approval of the Committee, obtain sites on the ground on the payment of a small premium.

RULES AND REGULATIONS cont....

10. Championship Points: Points will be awarded as follows:

- Champion points will not be awarded where there is no competition. Competition shall mean two or more exhibits.
 - In the event of a tie, e.g. 1st equal, the points for 1st and 2nd place are added together and divided; likewise, points for 2nd and 3rd are divided in a 2nd equal placing.
 - In cases where entries are made in the names of different members of one family, this must be clearly marked, e.g. – *AB Jones Family* and this will go into the Malvern Mounted Rifles family competition. All entries made individually will go into the Johnson Family Salver competition.
 - If less then three entries in a horse class, then only second prize money will be paid out.
11. Persons in charge of exhibits will be admitted free upon producing an Exhibitor's Pass, and they shall be subject to the orders of the Committee or its Officers.
12. In cases where non-members exhibitor's entry fees amount to a minimum of \$15.00, such exhibitors will be entitled to an Exhibitors Pass. Members Exhibitor Passes shall be issued at the discretion of the Committee.
13. The Committee reserves the right to substitute trophies in lieu of cash prizes should any offers of same come to hand after having the Schedule printed.
14. All entries must be made in writing and accompanied by entry fees.
15. Where two (2) persons tie in the number of points for a trophy, the number of first placings shall decide the winner, but at the discretion of the Committee.
16. All Trophies for all sections can be viewed on Show Day upstairs in the Pavilion. Trophy winners may have their photo taken with the trophy on the day, but all Trophies will remain with the Association and not to be removed from the grounds.

RULES AND REGULATIONS cont....

17. (a) Should an exhibitor, in the opinion of the Committee, be guilty of any fraudulent or unfair practice, or any deceit or concealment in entering or exhibiting stock or any other, or exhibit diseased or infected stock, all the exhibits of such an exhibitor shall be disqualified, and his/her name shall not appear in the official prize list.
 - (b) Should any exhibitor infringe any of these conditions and regulations or refuse to comply with the direction of the Committee, the Committee shall have power to suspend such person or firm from exhibiting at any exhibition during such period as they may think fit.
 - (c) Should any person or firms be disqualified or suspended by a kindred Association registered under the Agricultural and Pastoral Societies Act, 1908. The Committee of the Association shall have power to endorse such disqualifications or suspension and suspend such person or firm accordingly.
18. All Equestrian competitors must have a current measuring certificate and carry a RAS Performance/ID card. The Malvern A&P Assn offer a temporary measuring certificate for local competitors only, who reside in the Malvern District. The cost for this is \$10.
 19. Refund of Entry Fees in the Horse Section: The Association will credit 80% of entries only on production of Veterinary Certificate or presentation of a Medical Certificate for the rider. No refunds will occur after the 11th April 2025.
 20. In respect of District Classes, the District is defined by the former Malvern County Boundaries, and exhibitors in these classes must permanently reside in the for Malvern County area.
 21. The Show will be run under R.A.S. rules.
 22. **HATS AND SAFETY HELMETS:** From the 1st of August 2017 all equestrian riders, including harness drivers must wear approved safety helmet. The standards can be found at the following link:

Helmet compliance is the responsibility of the rider/parent.
 23. **Back numbers:** Number holders are encouraged to be used by all competitors using the appropriate number that the Show issues. Those who require a back number, please indicate on the entry form and one will be provided at a cost of \$4 per back number. Hunter jumpers are required to use the Associations back numbers. The \$4 is to be paid with the entry fee, \$2 of which is refundable on the return of the back number in good condition.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ

- Rules and Regulations. Refer to Schedule.
- **NO DOGS** will be admitted to the grounds unless they are collared and leashed. The Malvern A&P Association requests that all dogs be treated as below before entering the grounds:
Dose all dogs with a praziquantel drug at least 48 hours or within one month prior to going to the event. Carry some evidence of treatment such as a treatment certificate or receipt from the vet. Carry enough plastic bags to pick up and remove dog faeces should your dog defecate. If you are going on public land near sheep pasture please apply the same policies to prevent the spread of sheep measles. If you are in any doubt or have questions please contact Ovis Management on 0800 222 011 or visit www.sheepmeasles.co.nz
- Privacy Act - Exhibitors agree to results from classes being published where appropriate.
- Competitors who accept a ribbon are expected to parade in the Grand Parade.
- Prize Money - All money not paid out at the time of competition will be paid at the Event Administrator's office on Show Day **AFTER** the Grand Parade. Please ensure that you have your Entry Form or Personal Identification.
- Horse Back Numbers (Hunters Only & Leisure Horses) - Refunds will be made from the Event Administrator's Office during the day.
- St John Ambulance is on site and is situated in the middle on the north side of the Main ring.
- Roecombe Road - will be closed for parking. It will be classed as an additional entrance to the Show and the usual admission charge will be levied.
- Exits - In the event of an emergency the exits are clearly marked in all four corners of the grounds.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ENTRY FEES:

\$1.25 per class per horse has been included to cover RAS charges and levies.

Breastplate number holders are compulsory for all classes, except Hunter jumping, Pony Hunter jumping and Recreational (Leisure) Horse & Pony. The competitor is responsible for making the number using the appropriate number that the show issues. Only large black numbers on a white background are acceptable. No other colour combinations or formats are acceptable. Back numbers are \$4 and are to be paid for with the entry fees. The back numbers are to be collected from the Administrator's Office, (upstairs in the Pavillion), and returned to the Administrator's Office (in good condition) for a \$2 refund.

Please Note:

1. All competitors and exhibitors ride and exhibit at their own risk.
2. It is intended that we irrigate, however, this is dependent on District By Laws at the time.
3. Information re safety helmets.
4. Boundaries for our District.
5. Horses and Ponies 3 years and under must not be ridden.
6. Age of Riders/Handler/Horses/Ponies are as at 1 August 2024

Horse Section Rules & Regulations:

(1) ALL CLASSES ARE RUN UNDER RAS RULES

(2) HEIGHT CERTIFICATES AND MEASURING:

All exhibitors (with the exception of the Recreational (Pleasure) Horse & Pony Section) must carry an official RAS Life or Horse/Pony Annual Height and Performance Card, or Malvern A&P Assn Temporary Measuring Certificate (TMC). Failure to do so will result in elimination.

Measuring for a TMC, is for Malvern Show District Boundary Competitors only, will be available on the grounds. Only horses/ponies presented in a bridle and under suitable control will be measured for a TMC, between 7.30am until 8.15am. \$10 per horse/pony to be paid at time of measuring (cash only).

(3) CLEAN SPORT:

Clean Sport - The rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible's risk. Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardiovascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

(4) NOVICE CLASSIFICATION

A Novice is a Horse or Pony which has not won 6 (six) firsts in conformation classes at any A & P Show at the time of the Show (Ladies and Gentleman's Hack class wins DO NOT count as an Open Conformation win and are not recorded). If a Novice entry has gained 6 wins by the day of the Show, the Competitor must advise the Secretary and may change

to an Open class within the Sub-Section, or if no class remains to enter a refund which will be actioned after the Show.

A Novice Hunter is a Horse or Pony which has not won 6 firsts in Hunter Jumping. Please note that a record of wins will be asked for. Horse/Pony height and performance cards must be carried. Failure to do so will result in elimination. Central Districts of the RAS collates all A & P Show results to enable Secretaries to keep a record of all Novice wins. Novices may enter the Open Classes.

(5) It is compulsory for all stallions and colts, except foals, to wear two (2) official "S" identification badges. One attached to each side of their bridle, at all Shows /Events at all times. The rider/handler must also wear **two (2) RAS official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring.** "S" badges are to be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ; armbands are available from RAS Head Office. Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest at Shows/Events when outside the show ring. Vests can be purchased from RAS Head Office.

(6) DISTRICT RULE

Horse and rider must reside in District to compete in District Classes.

DEFINITION OF MALVERN DISTRICT COUNTY: (Formerly Old Malvern County)

Area between the Waimakariri River to the Rakaia River. West side of Intake Road, South side of the Old West Coast Road from Intake Road to Sandy Knolls Road; West side of Sandy Knolls Road down to West side of Aylesbury Road to Burnham. West side of Main South Road from Burnham to the Selwyn River up to Mitchells Road, a line from corner of Hororata/Dunsandel Road to Te Pirita Road, West side of Te Pirita Road down to Rakaia Terrace Road, from North side of Rakaia Terrace Road up to Steels Road; West side of Steels Road to the Rakaia River.

(7) OWNERSHIP

All horses and ponies entered in competitive classes or ring events or parading must be in the name of the bona fide owner. All animals must be named at time of entry.

(8) LEASES

Leases or partnerships must be for no less than a six-month period and shall commence and must be lodged with the RAS.

(9) HATS AND SAFETY HELMETS

- a) In all cases current WorkSafe New Zealand rules prevail.
- b) All riders, including harness drivers/with the exclusion of heavy horse (Clydesdale) working classes, competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows/Events must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within a Showgrounds or the grounds of an affiliated Event.
- c) Hats/helmets must conform with one of the current approved safety standards. These standards may be subject to change but the latest list can be found at <http://www.ras.org.nz> – equestrian. RAS will advise any changes via their website and Facebook.
- d) **All hats/helmets that conform as per c) must be identified by the current tag system implemented by NZPCA, ESNZ and RAS. YELLOW TAGGED HELMETS ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL RIDERS WHEN MOUNTED. NO YELLOW TAG - NO ENTRY INTO THE RING - NO EXCEPTION**

(10) WHISKER and INNER EAR TRIMMING - as from 1 January 2022 - <https://www.ras.org.nz/equestrian/whisker-and-inner-ear-trimming/>

(11) A JUDGES TRAVEL FUND has also been introduced

to assist with judges' travelling expenses at \$5 per competitor/exhibitor.

(12) The committee has the right to amalgamate classes if insufficient entries.

(13) If fewer than three entries in a class, then only second prize money will be paid out. Horses are only eligible for one section. However riders can enter their rider class in whichever applicable section.

(14) If entering more than one section please note that rings will not be held up waiting for competitors to finish classes in other rings.

(15) **RIGHTS OF THE COMMITTEE** - The committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without giving any reason for doing so and reserves the right to make any alteration to the show timetable or withdraw any event as may be deemed desirable. If there are insufficient entries in a class at close of entries, classes may be combined. Any unruly or dangerous animal or exhibit may be required to leave the showgrounds.

(16) Do not be late for your classes. Stewards/Judges will not be waiting for competitors who are late to their ring.
